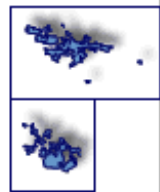

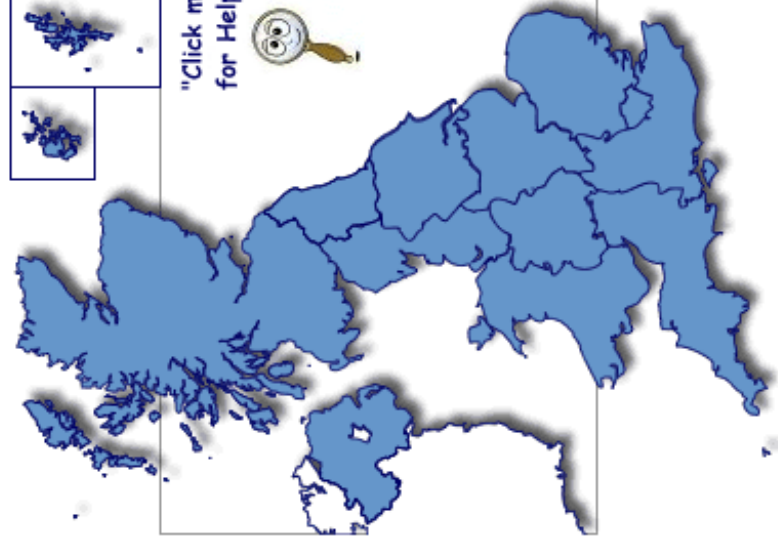

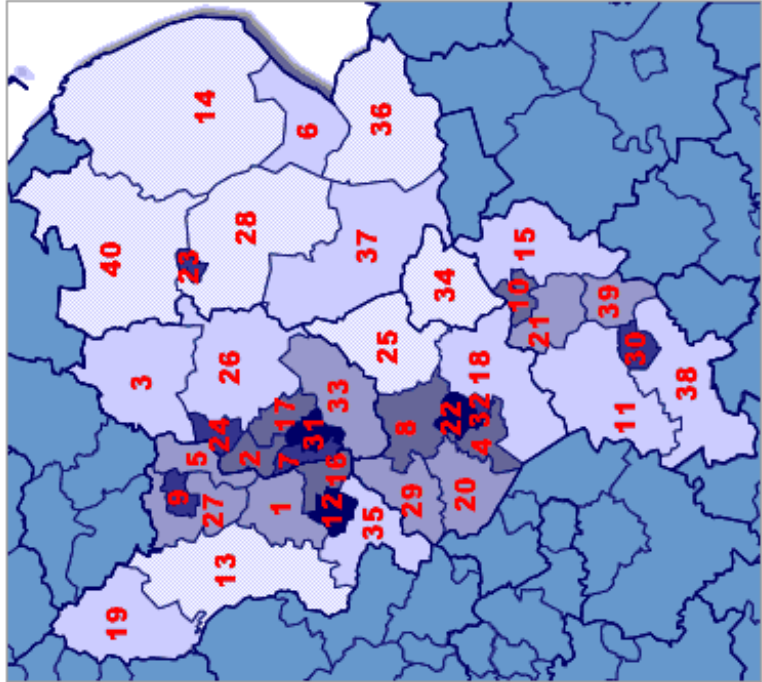

Disclaimer:

It should be noted that the information shown below has been calculated from data held on the Neighbourhood Statistics database. Population:

The resident population of Hedge End St. John's in mid 1998 was 6300 people, 6 per cent of the population of Eastleigh local authority. 19 percent of Hedge End St. John's population in mid 1998 were aged under 16, 61 per cent were aged between 16 and 59 and 20 per cent were aged 60 and over. This compares with 21, 61 and 18 per cent respectively for Eastleigh as a whole.

Vital Statistics:

A total of 68 live births to mothers usually resident in Hedge End St. John's and 51 deaths of residents of this ward were registered in 1998. These represented crude rates of 11 births and 8 deaths per thousand residents compared with 12 and 8 respectively across the whole of Eastleigh local authority.

Therefore, you are encouraged to provide your thoughts on the pilot and any suggestions that would improve the service of delivering 2001 Census results. Your comments can be provided either by using the open discussion forum on the Feedback tab or by downloading the questionnaire and returning it to GROS Customer Services.

This home page provides access to the pilots two main services: QuickSCROL and SCROL Analyser. QuickSCROL provides the ability to obtain Census summary reports using modified data from the 1991 Census for an area of interest, e.g. Grangemouth. It also provides thematic maps for a number of topics down to postcode sector level. SCROL Analyser, also using modified data from the 1991 Census, enables the user to select more detailed information about a particular topic and then select the area that they are interested in using the on-line mapping tool. Once the information has been retrieved, the user has the ability to create charts or thematic maps to help interpret the data. 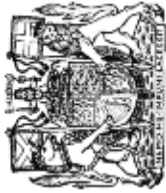

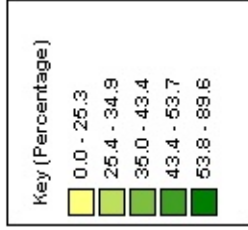

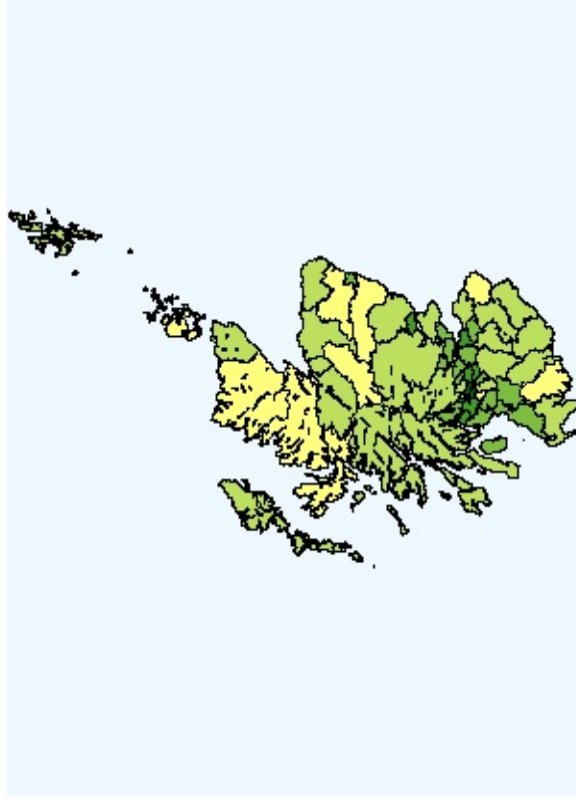


Scotland's CENSUS 29 APRIL 2001
