Children's Dental Health in the United Kingdom 2003: Symposium

The 2003 Children's Dental Health Survey, commissioned by the four United Kingdom Health Departments, is the fourth in a series of national children's dental health surveys that have been carried out every 10 years since 1973 in England and Wales and in the whole of the UK since 1983. The survey provides information on the dental health of children in the United Kingdom, measures changes in oral health since the last survey in 1993 and provides information on children's experiences of dental care and treatment and their oral hygiene.

This Symposium brings together the leading academics involved with the survey, to provide policy makers, practitioners and academics greater insight into the findings.

The 2003 Children's Dental Health Survey was in the field from October to December 2003 and findings to date from the survey have been published.

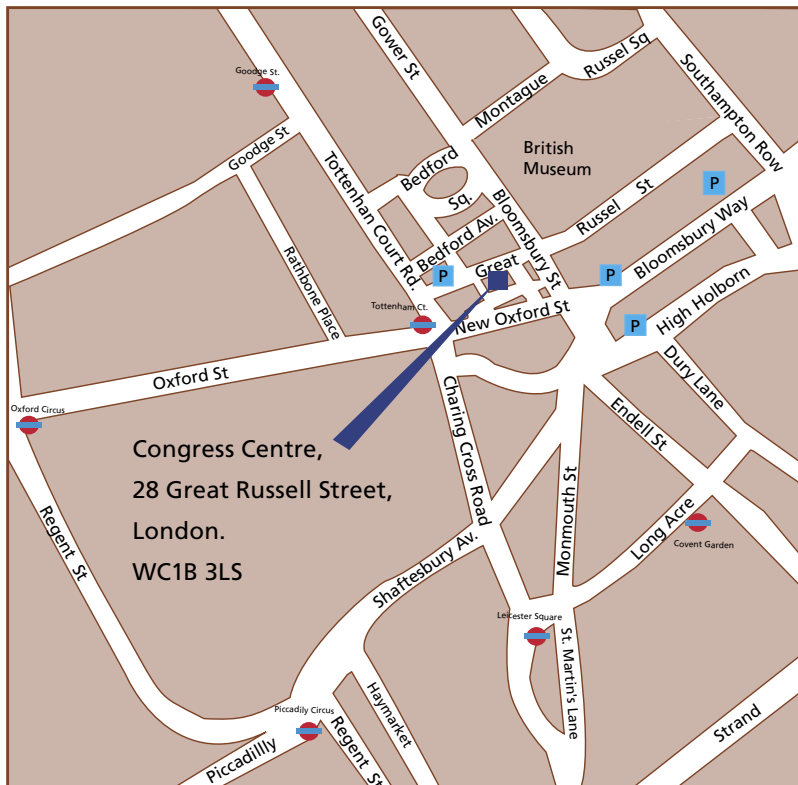
