



# REVIEW OF PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCIES IN CUMBRIA

## REVISED RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCIES IN CUMBRIA

**NOTICE** is given today, 28 June 2001, under the Parliamentary Constituencies Act 1986 (as amended) that the Boundary Commission for England, having considered the report produced by Mrs Suzan P Matthews QC of the local inquiry held in Carlisle on 16, 17 and 18 January 2001, have decided to revise their provisional recommendations for four parliamentary constituencies in the county.

The Commission now recommend (2000 electorates in brackets):-

- (a) That no change be made to the following provisionally recommended constituencies:-

**CARLISLE BOROUGH CONSTITUENCY (63,001)**  
**WESTMORLAND AND LONSDALE COUNTY CONSTITUENCY (67,303)**

- (b) That the composition of the four revised constituencies will be:-

**BARROW AND FURNESS COUNTY CONSTITUENCY (69,142).** The Borough of **Barrow-in-Furness**; and nine wards of the District of **South Lakeland**:- Broughton, Crake Valley, Low Furness & Swarthmoor, Ulverston Central, Ulverston East, Ulverston North, Ulverston South, Ulverston Town, Ulverston West.

**COPELAND COUNTY CONSTITUENCY (62,517).** Four wards of the Borough of **Allerdale**:- Crummock, Dalton, Derwent Valley, Keswick; and the Borough of **Copeland**.

**PENRITH AND THE BORDER COUNTY CONSTITUENCY (61,000).** Two wards of the Borough of **Allerdale**:- Warnell, Wigton; seven wards of the City of **Carlisle**:- Brampton, Great Corby and Geltsdale, Hayton, Irthing, Longtown & Rockcliffe, Lyne, Stanwix Rural; and the District of **Eden**.

**WORKINGTON COUNTY CONSTITUENCY (61,369).** Twenty-five wards of the Borough of **Allerdale**:- All Saints, Aspatria, Boltons, Broughton St Bridget's, Christchurch, Clifton, Ellen, Ellenborough, Ewanrigg, Flimby, Harrington, Holme, Marsh, Moorclose, Moss Bay, Netherhall, St John's, St Michael's, Seaton, Silloth, Solway, Stainburn, Wampool, Waver, Wharrels.

The Commission wish to stress that these recommendations relate solely to parliamentary constituencies and do not affect the structure or arrangements of local government or the services they provide.

The above wards were created by:- The Borough of Allerdale (Electoral Changes) Order 1998; The City of Carlisle (Electoral Changes) Order 1998; and The District of South Lakeland (Electoral Changes) Order 1998.
