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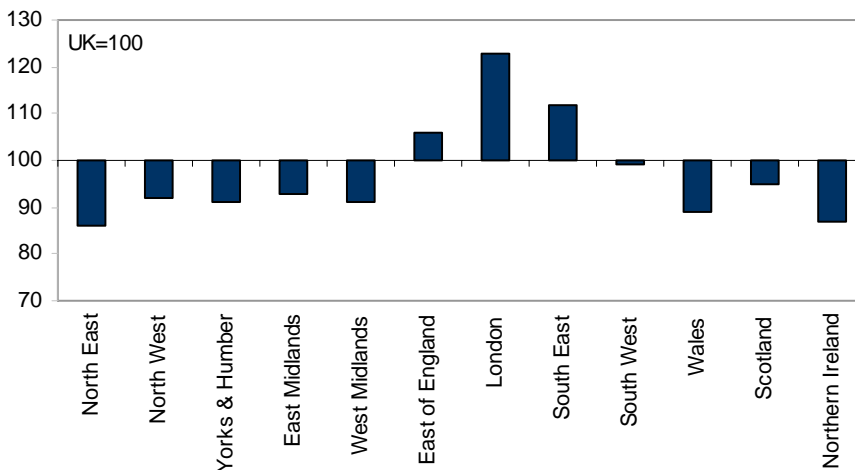
Regional Disposable Household Income

Regional Disposable Household Income (NUTS1)

London's disposable household income per head was 23 per cent above the average for the United Kingdom in 2006 while the North East was 14 per cent below the UK average, according to estimates published by the Office for National Statistics.

In 2006, regional income per head was above the national average in three regions: East of England (£14,600), London (£16,900) and South East (£15,400). The lowest household incomes per head in 2006 were in the North East (£11,800) and Northern Ireland (£12,000). Household income per head increased at similar rates in all regions between 2005 and 2006. This pattern is little different from previous estimates.

Sub-regional household income (NUTS2)

Within the sub-regions the picture is also little changed. Inner London had the largest household income per head (£18,800) for 2006 within the 37 sub-regions of the United Kingdom (mainly groups of counties); West Midlands had the lowest (£11,600).

Local household income (NUTS3)

The 2006 estimates for the 133 local areas (principally individual counties and unitary authorities) of the UK show Inner London West had the largest household income per head (£25,700). Nottingham had the smallest household income per head (£10,200).

Regional, sub-regional and local household income

Regional household income estimates for 2006 are being released today along with revisions for the period 1995 to 2005. The estimates update those published in March 2007.

Household income estimates are available at various geographical levels known as NUTS1 (government office regions and countries of the UK), NUTS2 (mainly groups of counties and unitary authorities), and NUTS3 (principally individual counties and unitary authorities). See background note 3. A detailed breakdown of household income components at NUTS1 and NUTS2 is published today. Total household disposable income, balance of primary income and balance of secondary income are published for the NUTS3 regions.

Household income represents the amount of money available to households less taxes, National Insurance and pension contributions and interest paid.

Regional household income estimates (1995-2006)

Growth rates of total GDHI

Total gross disposable household income (GDHI), before allowing for inflation has been increasing in all UK regions. In 2006, the highest growth was in Northern Ireland (4.0 per cent) and the lowest in East of England and South East (3.2 per cent). Overall UK growth in 2006 was 3.5 per cent.

GDHI per head of population

Household income per head of population for the UK as a whole, excluding income that cannot be assigned to any region (see background note 4) was £13,800 in 2006. London had the highest GDHI per head of population (£16,900) which is a per head index of 123 i.e. 23 per cent above the UK average. The North East had the lowest (£11,800) 14 index points (86) below the UK average. This is followed by Northern Ireland (87) and Wales (89).

Shares of GDHI

London and the South East each had a 15 per cent share of the United Kingdom's disposable income. England's share was 85 per cent; Scotland's 8 per cent, Wales's 4 per cent and Northern Ireland's 3 per cent of total GDHI. Extra-regio (GDHI which cannot be assigned to any region such as activities on the continental shelf and the GDHI of embassies and the armed forces) had a share of 0.2 per cent of GDHI.

Sub-regional and local household income estimates (1995 to 2006)

Growth rates of total GDHI

Household income has been increasing in all NUTS2 regions. Inner London had the highest GDHI per head (£18,800) which is 37 per cent higher than the UK average. The sub region West Midlands had the lowest GDHI per head (£11,600) which is 16 per cent lower than the UK average.

In 2006 Inner London West had the highest GDHI per head (£25,700) of all local areas, 87 per cent above the UK average. Nottingham has the lowest (£10,200) 26 per cent below the UK average.

Revisions

Revisions to the regional household income estimates in this release cover the period 1995 to 2005. The revisions are relatively small this year. The main reasons for revisions since the March 2007 publication are:

- Revisions to the national estimates for the UK (National Accounts Blue Book 2007) -which go back to 2004
- Replacing provisional estimates with actual data, e.g. latest available HMRC pay-as-you-earn data replaces previously used estimates back to 2004/05.
- Further changes due to replacing estimates with actual data and methodological improvements.

Future work plans

ONS plans to publish estimates of regional GVA for 2007 in December 2008.

BACKGROUND NOTES

1. The Household Sector

The household sector covers people living in traditional households as well as those living in institutions, such as retirement homes and prisons. The sector also includes sole trader enterprises and non-profit institutions serving households (NPISHs) for example, charities and most universities.

The estimates presented in this release are consistent with the national accounts published in the 2007 edition of the UK National Accounts, *The National Accounts Blue Book*, which also defines the terms used.

Total gross disposable household income is derived from the balances of *primary* and *secondary income*.

Balance of Primary Income
+ Balance of Secondary Income
Gross Disposable Household Income

The balance of *primary income* is the difference between *total primary resources* and *uses*.

Total Primary Resources
- Total Primary Uses
Balance of Primary Income

Total primary resources: Compensation of employees (all income from employment), operating surplus (mainly rental, imputed or otherwise, in the household sector), mixed income (income from self-employment) and property income receipts.

Total primary uses: property income paid.

The balance of *secondary income* is derived from *total secondary resources* less *uses*.

Total secondary resources: social benefits received, other current transfers received (financial gifts, non-life insurance claims etc.)

Total secondary uses: current taxes on income and wealth (income tax, council tax), social contributions paid (employees pension / social security contributions), other current transfers paid.

2. General

The GDHI estimates presented here are on a residence basis. This means that incomes of individuals are allocated to the region in which they live.

The headline GDHI series have been calculated using a five-year end point moving average. This removes some year to year volatility and regional volatility due to sampling and non-sampling errors in the unadjusted data sources. The unadjusted series are also provided for information on the National Statistics website.

Unadjusted GDHI estimates and components at NUTS2 will be supplied to Eurostat. These data are not directly used to inform funding decisions but may support arguments in the debate around the relative welfare of regions across the UK and the EU area.

3. Geography

The Nomenclature of Units for Territorial Statistics (NUTS) provides a single uniform breakdown for the production of regional statistics for the European Union. There are three levels of NUTS in the UK:

NUTS1: Government Office Regions and Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland.

NUTS2: 37 areas - sometimes referred to as sub-regions.

NUTS3: 133 areas - generally groups of unitary authorities or districts, also known as local areas.

Some areas appear at more than one level, for example, Northern Ireland appears at NUTS levels 1 and 2.

4. Extra-regio

The contribution to regional household income of UK embassies abroad and UK forces stationed overseas, which cannot be assigned to specific regions, is included in Extra-regio.

5. Accuracy

As with the national accounts, regional estimates (NUTS1, 2, 3) are calculated as accurately as possible within the available resources. There is no easy way to measure the accuracy of the estimates but ONS carries out consistency checks on data inputs, applies methods consistently and makes use of local knowledge for England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. The estimates are partly based on sample surveys and the quality of the results therefore varies according to sample size. This means that the results for smaller regions are subject to a greater degree of uncertainty than those for larger regions.
