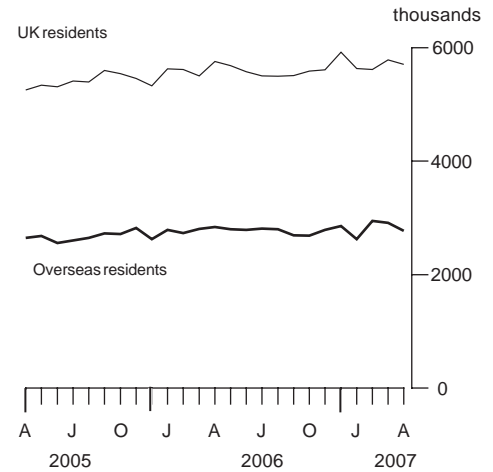

Overseas travel and tourism April 2007

In the three months to April 2007, compared with the previous three months, the seasonally adjusted results from the International Passenger Survey showed that:

- Overseas residents' visits to the UK increased in number by 4 per cent to 8.6 million
- Overseas earnings increased by 3 per cent to £3.9 billion
- UK residents' visits abroad remained broadly the same at 17.1 million
- UK residents' expenditure abroad increased by 1 per cent to £8.3 billion

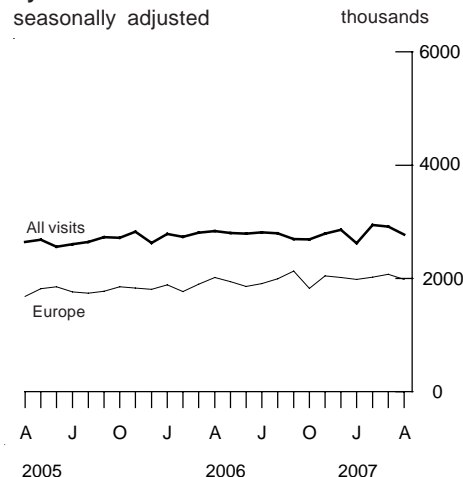


Overseas visitors to the UK

The estimated number of overseas residents' visits to the UK, seasonally adjusted, in the three months to April 2007 increased by 4 per cent to 8.6 million compared with the previous three months and increased by 3 per cent compared with the three months to April 2006.

The total number of overseas residents' visits to the UK, not seasonally adjusted, increased by 5 per cent during the 12 months ending in April 2007 compared with a year earlier (from 30.7 million to 32.3 million). This was as a result of the number of visits from Europe increasing by 5 per cent (to 23.4 million), visits from North America increasing by 3 per cent (to 4.5 million) and visits from other parts of the world increasing by 6 per cent (to 4.4 million). Overseas residents' visits to the UK by month

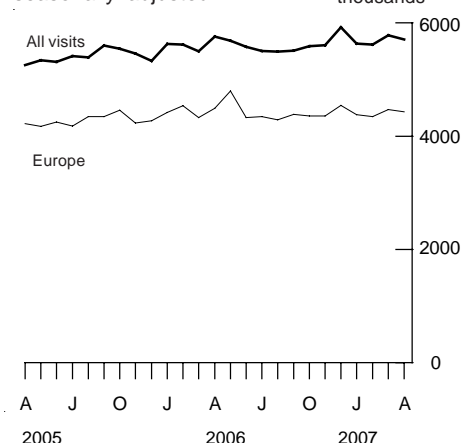


UK residents' visits abroad

The estimated number of UK residents' visits abroad, seasonally adjusted, in the three months to April 2007 remained broadly the same at 17.1 million compared with the previous three months and increased by 1 per cent compared with the three months to April 2006.

The total number of UK residents' visits overseas, not seasonally adjusted, increased by 2 per cent during the 12 months ending in April 2007 compared with a year earlier (from 67.3 million to 68.4 million). This was as a result of the number of visits to Europe increasing by 1 per cent (to 54.1 million), visits to North America decreasing by 4 per cent (to 4.5 million) and visits to other parts of the world increasing by 8 per cent (to 9.8 million). Overseas earnings and expenditure

Comparing the three months to April 2007, seasonally adjusted, with the previous three months, total spending by overseas visitors to the UK (earnings) increased by 3 per cent to £3.9 billion and spending by UK residents overseas (expenditure) increased by 1 per cent to £8.3 billion. This resulted in a deficit to the UK of £4.4 billion, unchanged compared with the three months to January 2007.

During the 12 months ending April 2007, not seasonally adjusted, overseas earnings increased by 6 per cent to £15.5 billion and expenditure by UK residents increased by 3 per cent to £33.8 billion compared with the previous year. This resulted in a deficit to the UK of £18.3 billion compared with £18.0 billion during the same period to April 2006. (Tables 1 and 4)

BACKGROUND NOTES

1. The figures in this First Release are based on provisional results from the *International Passenger Survey (IPS)*. The IPS is a sample survey and therefore the results are subject to sampling errors. Detailed analyses for Quarter 4 of 2006 may be obtained from the publication *MQ6 Overseas Travel and Tourism*. Further information and a full breakdown of the figures for 2005 can be obtained from the annual report, *Travel Trends* (ISBN 1-4039-9309-0) which was published on 8 November 2006. *Travel Trends* and *MQ6 Overseas Travel and Tourism* and a compact dataset, *Travelpac* (giving a selection of variables drawn from the survey) are available from the National Statistics website, www.statistics.gov.uk.
2. The main series are seasonally adjusted. This aids interpretation by identifying seasonal patterns and smoothing them out of the unadjusted data. The resulting figures give a more accurate indication of the underlying trend.
3. Figures for the most recent months are provisional and subject to revision in light of (a) more accurate data on passenger figures becoming available at the end of each quarter and (b) additional passenger data obtained at the end of the year, and the subsequent revisions to seasonally adjusted estimates that these entail. Non seasonally adjusted data has been revised for previously published time periods. The seasonally adjusted estimates have been revised along the length of the datasets to ensure both non seasonally adjusted and seasonally adjusted estimates are on a consistent basis. An annual review of seasonal adjustment setting is planned for May and this may lead to additional revisions. With the introduction of Liverpool and Prestwick into the International Passenger Survey Sample from January 2005, methodology was changed to address a discontinuity in results in regional visits to the UK. 4. One indication of the reliability of the key indicators in this release can be obtained by monitoring the size of revisions. The table below records the size and pattern of revisions which have occurred over the last 5 years (from 1998 Q4 to 2003 Q3) to the following key, seasonally adjusted, estimates:
 - the number of visits by overseas residents to the UK (GMAT),
 - earnings made from overseas residents in the UK (GMAZ),
 - the number of visits abroad by UK residents (GMAX), and
 - expenditure abroad by UK residents (GMBB).



A statistical test has been applied to find out if the mean revision to each key indicator is statistically significantly different from zero. An asterisk (*) indicates where the mean revision has been found to be significantly different from zero. One indication of the reliability of the key indicators in this release can be obtained by monitoring the size of revisions.

From May 2004, only southern Cyprus is included in the EU27 figures. Where Cyprus is shown separately in a table, the figures relate to the whole island.
